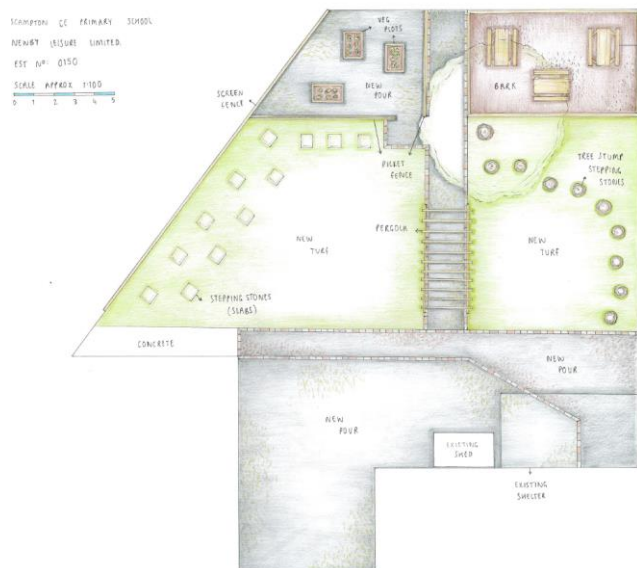
School Meals

School Uniform
